Hello brothers and sisters,

(I don't have a translator this time so I wrote the letter with my limited English!)

I would like to begin by thanking you for your prayers and for your responses to our letters. It is always encouraging to know that we are counting on the prayers of so many people.

Autumn is progressing and our move to Seville is fast approaching. **I would therefore like to share with you some news that will help you to pray for us during this period of transition (You will find the complete list of requests at the end of this letter):**

Ministerial adjustments at Sevilla: We are moving because we want, as I said before, **to work as a team with Macarena and Abraham.** However, we also want to **network more easily with other leaders and churches that have or want to emphasize discipleship and multiplication.** For this reason, we are right now in Toledo in a convention focused on discipleship, multiplication, and Church planting in Spain. I hope that once in Seville, I will be able to help so that the same enthusiasm and dynamism that I see in this event reach the churches in my region.

So I ask you to pray that our efforts with Abraham and Macarena in our neighborhood will bear fruit and that the churches in our region will develop a vision of conquering and multiplying disciples.

Zafra and Almendralejo: We continue with the Bible study group and our community activities in Zafra. The past few weeks have been very active:

Eugenia's Baptism: We had the joy of baptizing Eugenia, who has been attending our Bible studies for the past year. We did it together with the Church of Almendralejo. **I'm so glad to see her take steps of obedience in faith. Her daughter and husband were there, which is a real miracle!** Until then, he wouldn't even lend her the car to attend our meetings. It means that there has been a significant change in attitude and I hope it will last.

In addition, we met Hessel. She is not yet a Christian, but her grandmother was and she took her to the Evangelical Church when she was little. Having this memory in her heart, **she wanted to know more about her grandmother's faith. So we invited her to our Bible studies.**

There is also Maria, I had already told you about her. She had always been generally open to spiritual things with us. **Recently, we gave her a Bible and she started reading it every day. As a result, she has lots of questions and she told us that she would like to attend the Bible studie group.** But we are going to offer her to start bible studies with her alone, because she is a true person of peace and if she ever comes to the Lord, we know that she can easily start a group with her own contacts.

- I ask you to pray that everything goes well on the day of **our move to Seville and that the Lord blesses our team and our goals.**
- **I would ask you to pray for our finances.** Living in Seville will double the price of rent. We could rent one bedroom to a student to compensate, but we would like to be able to practice hospitality with those that visit us from Canada. We, therefore, place this subject in the hands of the Lord and ask Him to provide **an additional \$600 per month.**
